) REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

This Report and Recommendation is submitted to the Honorable David W. Williams, United States District Judge, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §636(b)(2) and General Order 104-D of the United States District Court for the Central District of California.

On January 3, 1975, plaintiff filed this Complaint in propria persona, alleging a cause of action based on 42 U.S.C. §1983 and §1985.

On March 28, 1975, Motions to Dismiss were taken under submission.

Plaintiff seeks general and punitive damages from state employees for the violation and deprivation of rights guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States.

He alleges that he was arrested while driving and told to get a driver's license and a vehicle license which he claims are titles of nobility, and to pay for them with

1 Federal Reserve Notes, which are not backed by gold or
2 silver coin, in violation of the Constitution of the United
3 States. He further alleges that he was threatened with a
4 deprivation of his liberty and that all took place under
5 color, custom and usage of the California Vehicle Code.

6 Once in court, defendant Soares, a Municipal
7 Court Judge, refused to allow plaintiff to appear with
8 counsel of his own choice, a non-lawyer.

9 Plaintiff seeks damages.

10 The Complaint is frivolous. The acts complained
11 of were in the course of the enforcement of state statutes
12 whose constitutionality has long been established.

13 The claim that the issuance of Federal Reserve
14 Notes violates the Constitution of the United States was
15 recently, once again, laid to rest in this circuit. United
16 States v. Schmitz, No. 75-2056, __F.2d__, (9th Cir., Sept. 9,
17 1975); Milam v. United States, No. 72-1666, __F.2d__,
18 (9th Cir., Jan 29, 1974).

19 It is equally clear that restricting counsel to
20 members of an integrated bar is constitutionally permissible.
21 Guajardo v. Luna, 432 F.2d 1324 (5th Cir. 1970); United
22 States v. Stockheimer, 385 F.Supp. 979 (W.D. Wis., 1974).

23 The Magistrate finds that no claim upon which relief
24 may be granted is stated. It does not appear that the
25 Complaint can be amended to overcome this deficiency.

26 IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that plaintiff's
27 Motion to Dismiss be granted as to the moving parties and
28 as to all other parties, sua sponte. Fed. R. Civ. P.
29 12(b)(6).


