You did not produce an Oath of Office for each of the officers present at the time citation CJ 56370 was issued by Mr. Bemiller.

At no time have I requested a document which appears to have been made up at the whim of an administrative agency of the United States (CHP) in an effort to frustrate the production of public record by a government agency. Further this document has an air of having been produced by your office, complete with misspellings and utterly worthless, meaningless and of no merit.

In the event that I am incorrect, and you are sincere in your efforts to produce both public records, and discovery, and that somehow you are simply mistaken as to what an Oath of Office is, I have included the publicly available, subscribed Oath of CHP Commissioner Farrow as an example.
